1. The Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Commission ("the Commission") confirms receipt of the Annual B-BBEE Compliance Report submitted by Insimbi Industrial Holdings Limited on 19 June 2026, in compliance with section 13G(2) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act 53 of 2003, as amended. Following its assessment, the Commission notes that the entity qualifies as a Qualifying Small Enterprise (QSE).
2. The Commission further notes that the entity's overall B-BBEE status declined from Level 4 to Level 6, with the overall score decreasing from 81.24 points to 73.95 points compared to the previous reporting period.
3. The assessment nevertheless reflects continued implementation of initiatives under the Skills Development and Enterprise and Supplier Development elements, and the Commission acknowledges the entity's ongoing efforts to advance its transformation objectives.
4. The Commission further notes improvements under the Skills Development and Socio-Economic Development elements of 0.43 and 1.32 points, respectively.
5. Notwithstanding the above, the assessment also identified declines under the following priority elements:
 - Black Ownership - 1.87%;
 - Black Women Ownership – 0.61%;
 - Management Control – 0.24 points; and
 - Enterprise and Supplier Development – 8.51 points.
6. While the Commission recognises the entity's continued commitment to transformation, these areas require focused management attention to prevent further deterioration in overall B-BBEE performance.
7. The Commission therefore recommends that the entity strengthen governance, performance monitoring, and implementation of targeted corrective interventions across the identified elements to improve future compliance outcomes.

8. The Commission hereby notes the entity's Annual B-BBEE Compliance Report and looks forward to continued engagement in advancing the objectives of broad-based black economic empowerment and the promotion of an inclusive and sustainable economy.
